RE: COVID-19 Update

Booster Shot Mandate at The Towers Starting Wednesday, December 1, 2021

As stated in my last memo, beginning on Wednesday, December 1, 2021:

In order to enter The Towers (non-residents) we are mandating that all caregivers and those providing services to our residents to have received their booster shots, unless there is a medical or religious exemption on file.

People are eligible for the Moderna booster six months after completion of their last shot and the authorization was made for all Johnson & Johnson vaccine recipients to be eligible for a second shot two months after their initial dose. Our front desk staff has a process in place to determine if your last vaccine date precludes you from having your booster before Wednesday, December 1. If that is the case, you will need to show us your vaccination card with your first 2 doses or a negative COVID test within the past 7 days, until you are eligible to receive your booster shot.

For non-caregivers or those not providing services to our residents (e.g. individuals with medical appointments at our clinic), in order to enter The Towers you will need to show us your vaccination card with the first 2 vaccines and/or provide us with a negative COVID test within the past 7 days.

We have all been working so hard together to keep our residents and each other safe. As things evolve, we will all just evolve along with the changes. I am so proud of what we have accomplished together since COVID-19 began. This is just another step in everyone helping to provide a healthy and safe environment for us all.

I hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving and I wish you and yours a happy, healthy and peaceful holiday season!
