Exterior Dining and Entrance Site Work

Our solarium and our new entrance is closer to being finished in glass. Once installed, the glass will really complete the look and give our community an amazing window to enjoy sunlight through.

Work is going to commence on the actual roofing and then work can begin on our new entrance doors. Our new welcome desk, centrally located to between both buildings, will feature a lovely concierge style and approach. We look forward to welcoming you!
