Exterior Dining and Entrance Site Work


With temperatures starting to drop, there has been a push to get sidewalks poured and the first row of parking completed with asphalt.


Dining Space/Display Kitchen

The flooring vendor has been moving along quickly and as of the close of this week, the flooring in the space is installed (and protected with a special covering). Lighting continues to be installed and the hearing loop and PA system speakers are all being installed as well. It has become a game of Jenga at times to move the supplies so the teams can work.

Just a quick note about the hearing loop: there are separate loops in the main dining area and the café, so in either space, any resident who has a Bluetooth enabled assistive hearing device will be able to tune into any program with a microphone in use. The speakers in the space will also allow us to increase the ambiance of the dining experience by having some subtle music during service.

Lastly, in this space, the second fireplace is in the process of being installed. Picturing this space being tiled and having the TV (for presentations and slide shows) hung will really start to tie together this part of the dining space.
