
Tower East Entrance Opening & Living Room

We've received our official Temporary Certificate of Occupancy from the City of New Haven, and we can now open both sides of our campus, hurrah!

This is our beautiful new Tower East Entrance, which mirrors our Tower One Entrance, giving our campus much-needed cohesion between our buildings.

There are also some great chairs that we can use while we await transportation or loved ones coming to whisk us away to adventures.

Just as at the Tower One Entrance, guests will be greeted by our Front Desk Team and sign-in via our SINE System.



In the living room spaces inside Tower East, you'll find two seating areas that will allow for a comfortable waiting area for visitors, or a great place to slide off to for a conversation with friends and neighbors.





A few finishing touches here will include:

Installation of a Laundry Card Machine for Tower East

Mounting of the trio of wall mounted boxes for Notes for Gus, Notes for Tenant Council and the Rental Payment box for Finance.

We do have plans to replace the Tower East mailboxes as well. We're working on the details with the Postmaster General to help us accomplish this project.

Nearing full completion and having been used for a chorus rehearsal, we are in awe of the beauty and elegance of this space.

We're working with the millworkers on the final steps of installing the Ark and architectural lighting.

We'll move on to the finishing steps of mounting the TV and other technology and programming components.



We will move to completion in Mid-March with the installation of the secure Ark Doors that will be made of a gorgeous epoxy glass that will be backlit.



Outside the new glass pane double doors, you can see the lighting installed for the floor to ceiling art glass feature that will light our way into this amazing space.

No big deal, just 14,112 individual LED lights that will glow behind the custom designed glass panels.







Stage 1 Finishing Touches

We also want to highlight the interactive kiosk in the hallway next to the Tower One front desk (on the way to the café).


Please stop by and touch the screen; you can select from many wonderful options that allow you to view past residents, loved ones that have passed, access information about our community and more!
