Exterior Dining and Entrance Site Work

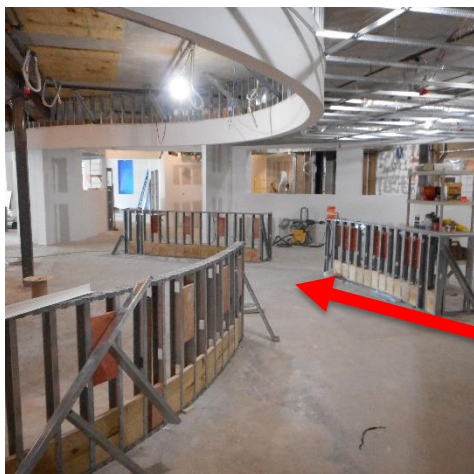


The floor for our exterior dining space has been poured and smoothed out; this space can be used several months out of the year to enjoy our meals outside.

We can't help but to imagine sitting out there with a nice cup of coffee and some fresh toast, enjoying the sounds of nature (and of New Haven) on a crisp spring morning. You might

The next steps here are to install a metal ceiling panel system and some overhead lighting. In the future we'll complete this space with planter boxes and some lovely floral accents.



Dining Space/Display Kitchen

Inside the dining space, things are starting to get ready to receive wall finishes, flooring, lighting and fire places.

Here you can see the two perch bars and counter seats in the Café. The perch bars will have our version of bar seats at a height our residents can enjoy.



These seats and the ones at the counter will allow our residents to be more involved in the process of meal making while also enjoying the smells, sounds and sights firsthand.

If you're at the counter seats, don't be surprised if one of Morrison's Culinarians passes you a pair of gloves and asks you to help knead the dough.

Upcoming Work

The biggest push right now is to fully enclose our Solarium so framing, brick work and window framing are what the focus has shifted towards.

This will also remedy the temporary concern of rain water making its way into our ground floor.

You can see here that they've started to close the area up and the brick work is progressing.

Atop the brick there will be great big windows to let in lots of natural light and warmth from the sun. Also a great space for that morning sip of coffee!
